3 days | 3-year certificate

This course comprehensively covers the practical skills needed by first aiders in most workplaces. Unless your workplace risk assessment indicates that the shorter *Emergency First Aid at Work* course covers all your needs and is sufficient for compliance with the regulations, this is essential training for your first aiders.

First Aid at Work Requalification

2 days | 3-year certificate

This course is for first aiders who've previously completed the *First Aid at Work* course and have a certificate that is due to expire. It covers the same comprehensive content as the three-day course but in two days so prior first aid knowledge and skills are a prerequisite and delegates must have previously held a *First Aid at Work* qualification.

Emergency First Aid at Work

1 day | 3-year certificate

If your workplace risk assessment indicates that first aid training covering emergency protocols only is sufficient, this course will help you meet your regulatory requirements.

Step 1:

Your learners go online for the theory modules

BLENDED TRAINING OPTIONS

First Aid at Work - Blended Online

3 days | 3-year certificate

The Blended Online First Aid at Work training course, provides a comprehensive set of practical skills needed by first aiders in most workplaces, giving both the ability and knowledge to deal with first aid emergencies. It combines online training with face-to-face training. The online section of this course must be completed before attending the face-to-face section.

First Aid at Work Requalification - Blended Online

2 days | 3-year certificate

The Blended Online First Aid at Work Requalification training course updates the first aid skills of those who need to renew their First Aid at Work certificate. It combines online training with face-to-face training. The online section of this course must be completed before attending the face-to-face section.





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ADDITIONAL FIRST AID TRAINING

Online Annual Refresher

No certificate

This interactive refresher course provides first aiders with an opportunity to practice and update their skills as a qualified first aider, at any time while their first aid certificate is valid.

The course involves 5 interactive modules:

- Choking
- Chest pains
- Severe Bleeds
- Recovery position
- Basic life support and AED

The course does not renew first aid certificates, or extend the validity period of certificates. It is for practice and refreshing skills only.

Blended Online Paediatric First Aid

2 days | 3-year certificate

Working in partnership with the Early Years Alliance, this Blended Online Paediatric First Aid course focuses on emergency scenarios that can happen when looking after young children and infants.

This course is for people who work with young children and those working towards an early years educator qualification. It meets the Ofsted Early Years and Childcare Register.

The course combines online training with 1 day of face-to-face training.

The online section of this course must be completed before attending the face-to-face section.

Automated External Defibrillation (AED)

3 hours | 1-year certificate

Cardiac arrest can happen to anyone and for each minute that passes without defibrillation, the chance of survival falls by about 10%*. This course requires no prior first aid knowledge and gives your employees the confidence to use a defibrillator and administer CPR in a life and death emergency.

CPR CertificateOn-site only

This short course covers all the essential skills for dealing with an unresponsive casualty.

Anaphylaxis First Aid

3 hours | 3-year certificate

Severe allergic reaction can kill without immediate first aid and the UK is one of the top countries in the world for instances of allergies. Chances are you have employees with serious allergies and this course, approved by Allergy UK, could be vital.

Medical Gases First Aid**

4 hours | 3-year certificate

Your risk assessment may indicate a need for training in the administration of oxygen and/or analgesic gas. This course covers the storage and administration of medical gas and equipment which can assist with resuscitation.

Healthcare Workplace Resuscitation**

2 hours | 3-year certificate

This short course is essential for healthcare professionals and others working in a healthcare setting. It ensures proficiency in performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) on adults. Those working with children should undertake separate training, such as *Paediatric first aid*.

Basic Sports First Aid

1 day | 3-year certificate

This course focuses on the necessary first aid skills to deal with a wide range of sporting incidents from bone, muscle and joint injuries to treatment of an unresponsive casualty.

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TAKING OWNERSHIP OF MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Training for your leaders and employees is essential in helping to build a stronger, more resilient and productive workforce with an open, stigma-free culture that enables people to talk freely about mental health and find the right support when it's needed.

By embedding our suite of mental health and wellbeing training across your organisation, you can:

- drive positive, long term cultural change across your organisation as part of a robust policy
- ➤ give your people the tools to keep themselves and their colleagues healthy
- ➤ build greater resilience and a stronger, happier and focussed workforce
- ➤ stop preventable mental health issues arising by building a supportive culture
- ➤ empower people with long-term mental health conditions to thrive at work
- encourage and help people to access support when it's needed, for a faster and full recovery
- ➤ significantly reduce the costs associated with mental ill health.

How to get started

A Government commissioned report* outlines six core standards, giving a framework for a set of actions that can be quickly implemented:

1. Produce, implement and communicate a mental health at work plan

Your plan should outline the approach to understanding, improving, protecting and monitoring the mental health of all employees, understanding the risks and building resilience. It should include training, and the support available to those who need it.

2. Develop mental health awareness among employees

Appointing trained employee Mental Health First Aiders and Mental Health Responders to offer peer support, and providing training for employees to develop their knowledge, understanding and resilience will help to overcome the stigma around mental health and build a stronger, more resilient workforce.

3. Encourage open conversations about mental health and the support available

This is about creating an environment in which employees feel able to talk openly without judgement. Consider appropriate training for all your line managers and team leaders so they have the understanding, skills and confidence to hold appropriate conversations.

4. Provide employees with good working conditions

Good working conditions where all occupational physical and mental health risks are assessed and appropriate measures implemented will allow everyone to get on in work and thrive. When employees are healthy and happy to be at work, everyone benefits.

5. Promote effective people management

Training in resilience building, understanding mental ill health, offering appropriate support and ensuring their own behaviours are positive is an excellent way to approach better people management. It's also vital that people who've been absent from work have a well-managed return.

6. Routinely monitor employee mental health and wellbeing

This is a key part of good occupational health and wellbeing management and should form part of your workplace wellbeing plan. Sickness and absence data can be used to spot problems and focus support. Employee surveys, mood trackers and other tools can help to improve communication and understanding of the risks.

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MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID TRAINING

Courses to give employers, managers and employees a grounding in the key factors to be aware of in your workplace.

Workplace Mental Health First Aider

2 days

This qualification teaches delegates to be workplace Mental Health First Aiders, who will be able to recognise the signs and symptoms of common workplace mental health issues and know how to effectively guide a person towards the right mental health support.

On this course delegates will gain:

- ➤ an in depth understanding of mental health and the factors that can affect wellbeing
- > practical skills to spot the triggers and signs of mental illness
- ➤ an understanding of how to perform some physical first aid as part of their response to mental illness
- ➤ the confidence to step in, reassure and support a person in distress
- ➤ knowledge on how to implement reasonable mental health adjustments when an individual returns to work
- ➤ the skills to create a positive mental health culture in the workplace.

Subject to passing all assessments, delegates will be awarded the FutureQuals Level 3 Award in Mental Health: Workplace First Aider qualification, valid for three years.

Workplace Mental Health Responder

1 day

This course qualifies delegates as Mental Health First Aid Responders, who will be able to use their knowledge of mental health conditions to promote positive attitudes towards mental health in the workplace. They'll also play a key role in supporting line managers that are assisting individuals who are returning to work after experiencing a mental illness.

The qualification is aimed at individuals who intend to take on the role of Mental Health Responder, but is also relevant to other employees and managers intending to develop their knowledge of mental health conditions.

On this course delegates will gain:

- > Roles and responsibilities of a Mental Health First Aid Responder
- ➤ What is the difference between a mental health episode, crisis and condition?
- ➤ Mental health action plan protocol (DR EFG)
- ➤ How to give immediate mental health support and where to signpost someone for additional support

On completion of the course, delegates will receive FutureQuals Level 2 Award in Mental Health: Workplace Responder qualification.



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ADDITIONAL MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID TRAINING

Mental Health: Workplace Skills Update

3½ hours

The mental health workplace skills update course ensures that mental health first aiders and responders keep their skills fresh and maintain their confidence to perform their roles effectively.

On this course delegates will:

- ➤ Knowledge update of the Mental Health First Aid protocols
- ➤ Knowledge update of how to recognise when an individual is experiencing poor mental health
- Skills update of how to support someone who is experiencing poor mental health
- ➤ Knowledge update of how to manage an individual who is in crisis
- ➤ Knowledge update of common mental health conditions.

On completion of the course, delegates will receive their certificate from St John Ambulance.

Youth Mental Health First Aid 2 days

This course is for anyone who works with or supports young people aged 8-18, such as school staff and youth workers. Certificate holders will be given the skills to spot the triggers of various mental health issues, the confidence to reassure and support a young person in distress, as well as supporting a young person with a long-term mental health issue and provide guidance to further help if required.

Youth Mental Health First Aiders are trained to do the same things as an Adult Mental Health First Aider (see top-left), but training is geared towards the very specific mental health needs of younger people.

On completion of the course, delegates will receive a *Youth Mental Health First Aider* certificate.

Mental Health - Supportive Conversations

3½ hours

During this course delegates will practice conversational techniques and gain self-assurance by experiencing different mental health situations and behaviours during role play scenarios with expert actors.

Currently this course is a live online course, delivered virtually through different sessions. It is only available for group bookings that are customised to the requirements of each business

On this course delegates will:

- ➤ be introduced to key mental health and wellbeing concepts and understand the impact of Covid-19 on mental health
- ➤ learn how to spot the signs of poor mental health
- ➤ explore the concept of human-centric management, the importance of trust and how to create a supportive work environment for effective relationships
- ➤ understand the key elements of a response: empathy, active listening, reassurance and support



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
